

Maybe you love your full-time job, but you want to earn some extra money on the side?





Matt drives his way through med school

A YEAR AGO MATT WAKELING WAS LIVING IN MELBOURNE AND WORKING IN IT.



While he didn't mind his job, he felt a strong pull to go back to school and follow his dream of being a doctor. At 29 year old, Matt felt like it was now or never, so he moved to Brisbane to begin studying medicine.

But, as any mature-age student knows, it's an expensive commitment. Between school fees, rent, living expenses, and study supplies Matt needed a **fast cash solution** to keep him on his feet in his new home.

"I thought to myself, how am I going to get back to university and pay the bills?" he recalls.

"Then I had the bright idea that I would go to uni and drive an Uber in-between."

But it wasn't that simple. Firstly, being new to Brisbane, Matt didn't know his way around. More importantly, he didn't have a car. So, Matt did what any millennial would do: he jumped on Google.

After some quick research Matt decided to rent a car through Easicar – a third party lender affiliated with GoGetta.

"I started looking around and found GoGetta.

I thought, how am I going to do this?"
remembers Matt. "I thought I might have to
get a loan - but then I saw the Easicar service,
who use GoGetta."

Matt signed up for a 12 month contract with the view to buy at the end, but also the option to return the vehicle and walk away with no further obligations. It was this flexibility that sold Matt - given the number of big changes he had made over the past year, he didn't want to be locked down into anything long term.

Matt has been driving for six months now in his new 2016 Hyundai Accent and estimates he has done around 2,000 trips. With another seven years of study ahead, he has no plans to stop driving soon.

His advice for new starters to Uber – give it time.

"When you try something new, there is going to be a period of discomfort," says Matt.

"For me, it was hard at first, because I didn't know any of the passengers or where I was going, I had to rely on Google Maps a lot - so it took about a month to really get into it and now I'm having a lot of fun."

Matt sings the praises of Uber, and insists it is a set-up that welcomes young drivers.

"I think the market is all for young people," says Matt, "and that goes for people who get in my car, too. They always get in the car and go, 'Oh! You're so young!' - and it's great to be an age that can relate with their clientele."






Your Uber checklist:

OPEN DRIVER'S LICENCE

- + Held licence for 1 or more years
- + Over 21 years old (UberX)
- + Over 20 years old (UberEATS)

DRIVER'S AUTHORISATION

- + Medical check
- + Background clearance for safety

ACCESS TO A VEHICLE NO OLDER THAN 9 YEARS (2007 MODEL OR NEWER)

- + 4 doors
- + Must seat up to 4 riders
- + Must be registered
- + Excellent condition
- + Not an ex-taxi
- + UberEATS allows motorbikes, bicycles or vehicles aged up to 15 years (2001 or newer)

CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE

- + Your name as insured driver
- + Expiry date must be current
- + Registration number
- + Vehicle make and model
- + Level of coverage



CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION

- + Registered owner's name
- + Expiry date must be current
- + Vehicle's registration number
- + Vehicle cannot be under a novated lease or registered in the name of a trust
- + If registered under a corporate name, please contact Uber for additional direction
- + Vehicle make and model

VEHICLE INSPECTION

- + At any time during your application process you can get your vehicle inspected for free
- + You must pass your inspection to become an active Uber driver



Mario on the road to success

AFTER 12 YEARS WORKING IN ACCOUNTING MARIO SILVERA LEFT HIS JOB TO START A NEW CAREER IN PROPERTY MANAGEMENT.



While transitioning from full-time to self-employment, Mario needed a side gig to bring in some cash, so he looked to Uber for a part-time driving job.

There was only one thing holding him back: his car.

Uber rides must be less than 10 years old. While Mario's 2007 Honda Civic just made the cut off, being manual and a small hatchback it was not ideal for the large amount of driving he was about to take on.

On the advice of his neighbour, Mario approached GoGetta about finance for a new car.

"I didn't want to spend too much on it," says Mario, "being new to Uber driving I didn't want to overextend my payments until I was sure. It was a calculated risk."

After much consideration on make and model, Mario sold his Honda and bought a 2011 automatic Hyundai i30, with help from GoGetta.

"I couldn't believe just how easy it was. I honestly felt like the stars aligned on this one!" laughs Mario.

In just a week, he went from chatting with his neighbour, finding the car, receiving finance, and joining the Uber team.

"In terms of the funding, I sat down with the GoGetta team on day one, and by the end of day one I had a response. By day two, I had a response from the car dealer, by day three I had found the car - and in a week? I had the car, I had the insurance organised, the car dealer had been paid, and I picked up my car the following week," he says.

When looking to buy an Uber-friendly car, Mario says there are three key criteria: low mileage, good fuel economy, and high resell value.

And once you start driving, he recommends you approach the job like any other profession - dress smartly and keep the car spotless at all times. His top tip? Be approachable.

"Don't turn up in a hotted up car," says Mario. "And don't play loud music!"

Despite his property business taking off, Mario plans to keep driving with Uber.

"I am always going to have spaces in between meetings and appointments where I can be working," Mario says.

"I've never been one to sit around and do nothing, I like keeping busy! I'll always be driving."
